Base Entry Instructions for Skeet Shooters

(Revised August 2025)

Red Chute Shotgun Sports Club on **Barksdale AFB** is open Tuesday & Thursday: Noon-Dusk & Saturday: 9am-Dusk. It is also open for Registered Skeet, Trap and Sporting Clays events on certain designated Shoot days. To get to the **Red Chute Shotgun Sports Club** during business hours or a registered shoot or special event, you must meet one of the following security requirements:

1. Individuals with current Military and/or Department of Defense credentials are welcome.
2. Other guests are welcome, with a current DBIDs ID. These photo IDs are issued by Base Security, after proper application and passing a background check. These IDs are a preferred method of getting base entry for Red Chute Club Members and frequent visitors. The IDs are good for 1 year and **there is no grace period**. Those who use these IDs need to file a new DBIDs ID application at least **2 weeks** prior to expiration.

Once the background check is completed and the ID is approved, you must come to the Security Police office on Range Road, just past the outdoor Museum on Lindeberg Rd. on a week day during office hours to get your photo taken and a new ID prepared. The phone no. there is (318) 456-3106.

If your old ID is still current, use it to enter the Base and drive to the Security Police office on Range Road.

If your old ID has expired, go to the Visitors Center at the Main entrance and request a temporary pass to get you in the gate and then go to the Security Police office on Range Road.

Contact **Dale Robison, Club Manager** at (318) 456-4582 or E-Mail him at dale.robison.1@us.af.mil to request an application form for a DBIDs ID.

3. Most shooters attending Skeet shoots that do not meet the identification requirements of 1 and 2 above, request to have their names placed on the base **Entry Access List [EAL]**. A new EAL is made for each Skeet shoot. To get on the EAL, we have to submit information to Base Security 10 days in advance of the Shoot. Security will run the background checks on that list for every shoot.

The information needed to be placed on the Entry Access List is as follows:

- A. Name as shown on your Driver's License.
- B. Your Date of Birth
- C. Driver's License Number and State of Issue (Include leading zeroes).
- D. Social Security Number.

If we do not already have your information above, send it to dougfrey@bellsouth.net and Doug will have you added to the list. The easy way is to email Doug a photo of your Driver's license and **all 9 digits** of your SS#. To be safe with your SS#, call Doug Frey at (318) 635-6218 or (318) 834-3098 and leave a voice mail. **You must present a "Real ID" or Passport to enter the base.**

Shooters under age 16, do not have to go through this process. Anyone else in your party, age 16 or older, does have to meet the requirements of 1, 2 or 3 above.

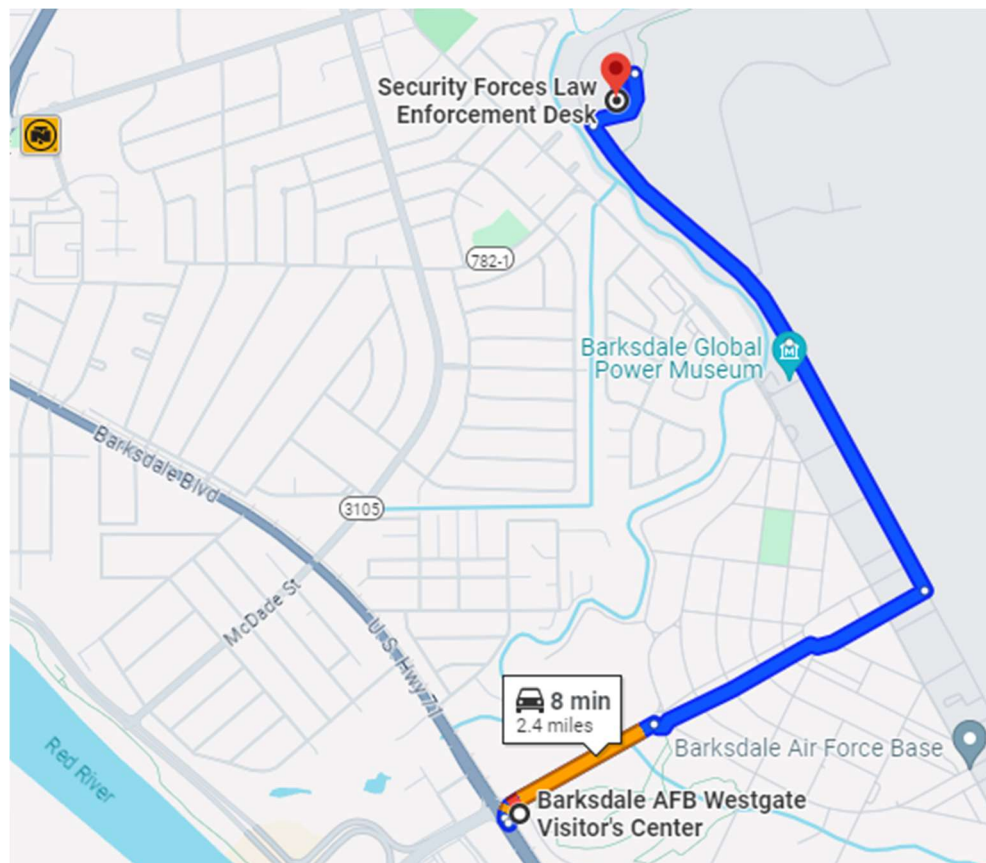

4. If you or anyone in your party do not meet the requirements of 1, 2 or 3 or do not sign-up in time get on the Entry Access List, you would have to go to the Visitor's Center at the Main Gate (West Gate) and meet a Club Representative who can Vouch for your Gate Pass. We need advance notice of this, in order to make arrangements for someone to meet you. This is the least efficient way to get on the Base and is a last resort.

With proper credentials or if you are on the Entry Access List, you may enter at any gate, **except** the Contractors Gate. If you are driving a Motor Home or pulling a camper, you **must** enter the Contractors Gate from Exit 23 on I -20. See attached maps for more information.

The Map below shows how to get to the Securities Police Office to obtain a DBIDS ID. If you have an unexpired DBIDS ID go to tis office to renew, after you have submitted a new application and it is approved. If your DBIDS ID is expired or its your first time to request one, submit a DBIDS ID Request to Dale Robison. Once it is approved, go to the Visitors Center to get a PASS to allow you to go to the Security Police office to get you DBIDS ID.



From Barksdale AFB Westgate Visitor's Center, Wilbur Wright Dr, Barksdale AFB, LA 71110, head northwest on Barksdale Blvd East to Lindbergh Rd turn left on Lindbergh Rd and Range Rd past the Museum planes to your destination [8 min (2.4 mi)] Security Forces Law Enforcement Desk Bossier City, LA 71112.

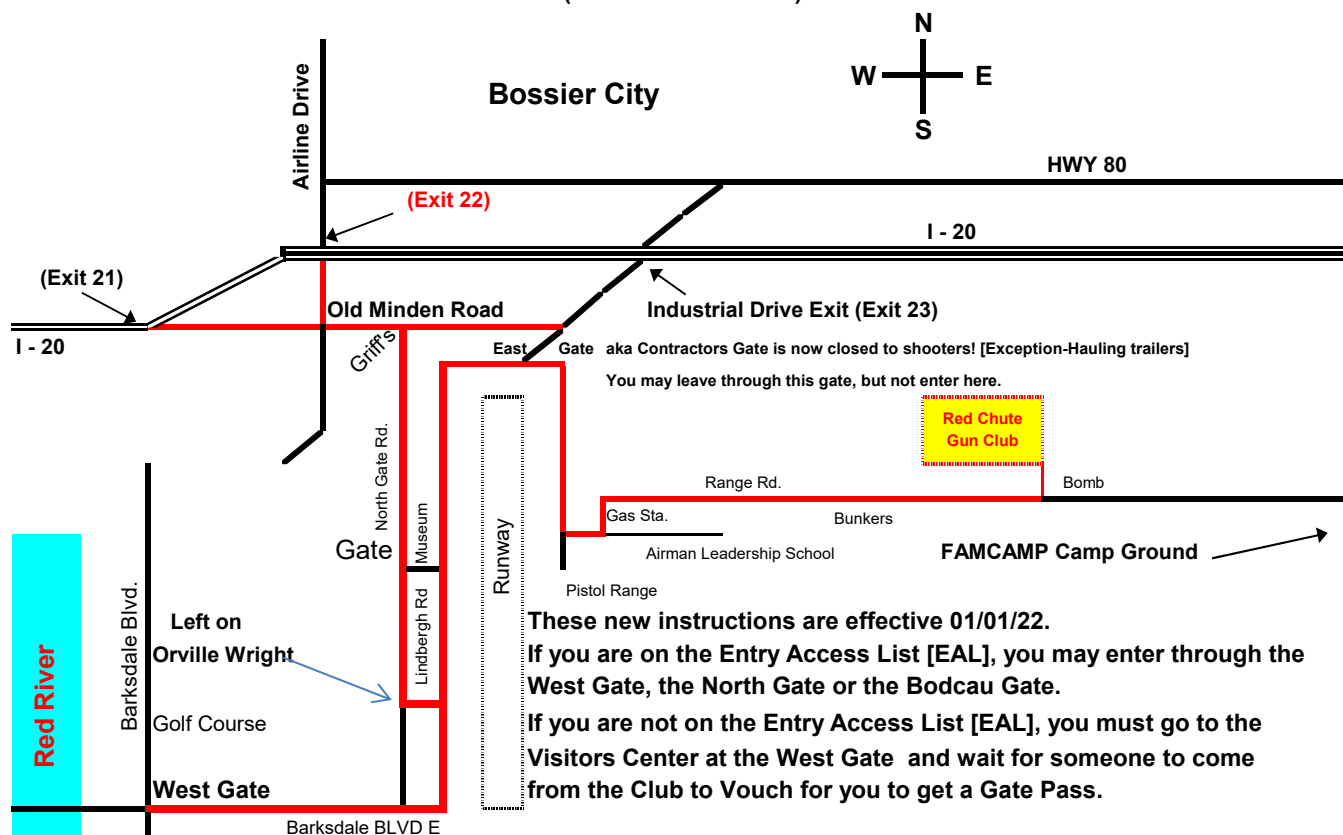

Obey all speed limits.

Directions through North Gate From I-20:

From I-20 Take the **Airline Drive Exit (Exit 22)** South to Old Minden Rd.

Turn left on Old Minden Rd. then right on North Gate Rd. to the North Gate of Barksdale AFB. Stop at the gate and give the guard your drivers license.

Explain to the guard that you are going to the Red Chute Gun Club and that your name should be on the **EAL** (Entry Access List). Drive into the base and turn left on Orville Wright then left again on Lindbergh going North through the Museum and out around the runway and South again until the road turns East and crosses a bridge. Caution, you should be driving 25 when crossing the bridge. Make an immediate left on Range Rd. driving past the military gas station. The road turns East again. Drive East on Range Rd. for 1.9 miles. You should see the sign for the club on the left. Turn left onto the gravel road next to the building with the Bomb in front. Drive through the gate and park.

Directions From Shreveport Bossier through West Gate:

From Shreveport cross Red River going East on West Gate Dr. Enter the West Gate also known as the (Main Gate). Drive East on Barksdale BLVD E to Lindbergh Rd and go left (North) through the Museum as explained above.

Directions From the Bodcau Gate are on the next page.

If you do not have a military ID or Base ID Card, contact shoot management 7-10 days in advance of your visit, so that we can add you to the EAL (Entry Access List).

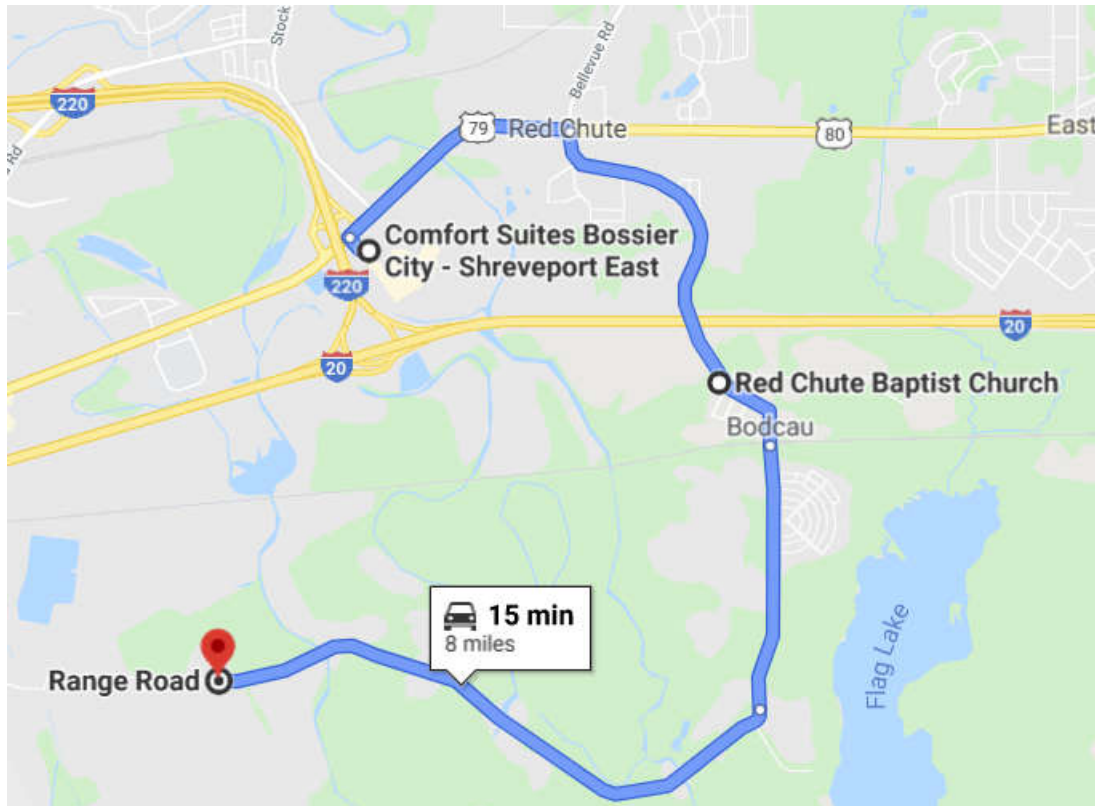

From US 80 go south on Bodcau Station Rd. Shortly after you pass Red Chute Baptist Church you will cross railroad tracks and arrive at the Bodcau Gate. Give the guard your driver's license and tell them you are on the EAL for Red Chute Shotgun Sports Club. Drive in on Lake Dr. pass the residential area, pass the Fire Station, turn right on to Range Rd. Drive past the FAMCAMP area to the gun club on the right. Look for red flag.

Contractors' Gate for RVs or Campers in Tow Only

If you are if you are towing a Camper or driving a Motor Home and are attending a Skeet shoot at **Red Chute Shotgun Sports Club** on **Barksdale AFB** and you have **current Military Credentials**, a **current DBIDS ID** or have made advance arrangements to be placed on the **Entry Access List [EAL]**, you **MUST** enter the **Contractor's Gate** from I-20 Exit 23.

After clearing security, turn left on Lindbergh out around the runway and South until the road turns East and crosses a bridge. Caution, you should be driving 25 when crossing the bridge. Make an immediate left on Range Rd. driving past the military gas station. The road turns East again. Drive East on Range Rd. for 1.9 miles. You should see the sign for the Gun Club on the left. To get to the FAMCAMP, keep driving East until you see the FAMCAMP signs on your right.
